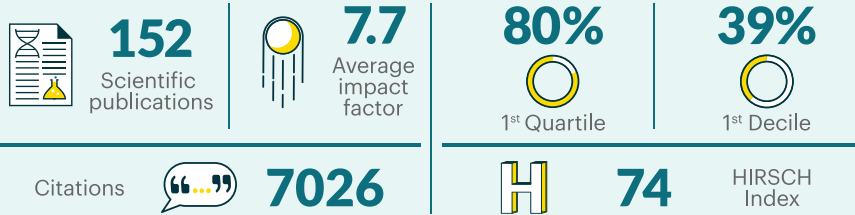


# 2019 At a Glance

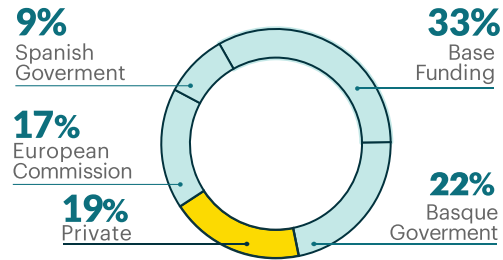
